Introduction (Times New Roman font, size 12, bold). Authors have to use this template to prepare their abstract to be submitted to Bioceramics 30 (Times New Roman font, size 12). Citations should be given with numbers in brackets [1] and listed at the end of the abstract.

Experimental. Total abstract length should be of **1 page** maximum. Any abstract exceeding 1 page will not be considered.

Results and Discussion. The text of the abstract should be written using the Times New Roman font, size 12. Subtitles should be in bold.

Conclusions. Save your abstract as **pdf file** before submission. Submission has to be done directly online on www.bioceramics30.org

Peer Review Criteria for Papers: Abstracts and manuscripts submitted to the Bioceramics31 are subject to a series of steps, which lead to the acceptance of manuscripts for publication or rejection. The abstracts submitted are sorted into different categories by an organizational committee. Then the conference chairs appoint appropriate reviewers for the abstracts from the program committee as well as experts in those specified disciplines. Abstracts will be accepted for either a poster or an oral presentation, or declined. The senior authors of the accepted abstracts may also be invited to submit a full-length manuscript (submission of manuscripts is optional), as well as to present the findings at meeting. Upon receipt of the optional, full-length manuscript, the conference chair will assign at least four reviewers for each paper to evaluate the originality and novelty of the research (Scores: 1=Rejection, 2= Modification by Program Committee, 3 = Acceptable, 4= Very Good Paper, and 5 = Excellent Work). Accepted manuscripts are considered refereed papers will be published in Bioceramics31 book that will be available at the meeting ([IAE Publisher](#)).

Student Awards:

Top undergraduate and graduate students for podium and poster presentations will be recognized (Cash prizes and Certificates) at the awards ceremony.
